CONTINGENT INFORMATION – Northern Territory

ELIGIBILITY

All applicants are reminded that attendance at a Jamboree is a privilege, not a right, and that behaviour standards will be monitored prior to the event before final approval is granted for attendance.

- Scout**
- Must be a registered Scout Section member of Scouts Australia NT at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019
 - Must have met the requirements, before October 2018, for either:
 - the Pioneer Badge; **OR**
 - Milestone 1 in their badge work, as well as Stage 3 in each of Bushcraft, Bushwalking and Camping
 - Have completed ten (10) nights in a tent as a Scout, at a Scout camp, with three (3) of those nights being consecutive. Camping with family, schools etc. will not be considered.
 - Have approval from their Scout Leader
 - Have approval from the Contingent Leader
 - Have consent from their parents/guardian
 - Not have had their 15th birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree

- Venturer Scout**
- Must be registered as a Venturer Scout member of Scouts Australia NT at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019
 - Be 15 years of age with at least 6 months service as a Venturer, before the opening day of the Jamboree, and should not have reached their 18 years by the end of the Jamboree
 - Have completed either the
 - Australia Scout Medallion; **OR**
 - Award or Venturing Skills Award; **OR**
 - Introduction to Venturer Scouts badge, as well as Stage 3 in each of Bushcraft, Bushwalking and Camping
 - Have a desire to provide service to Scouts
 - Be recommended by the Unit Council and Venturer Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form
 - Have approval from the Contingent Leader
 - Have consent from their parents/guardian
 - Hold a current NT Working with Children Card

- Rover Scout**
- Must be registered as a Rover member of Scouts Australia NT at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019
 - Be 18 years of age before the opening day of the Jamboree
 - Be recommended by their Crew Leader as being of excellent character, a good role model to Scouts and has the skills and abilities to undertake the activity (or other tasks) nominated on the application form
 - Be approved by the Contingent Leader
 - Not have had their 26th Birthday before the opening day of the Jamboree
 - Hold a current NPC and NT Working with Children Card

- Leader**
- Must hold a Certificate of Adult Appointment in Scouts Australia NSW as at 30 September 2018 and through till 16 January 2019
 - Be recommended by their Group Leader (or Leader-In-Charge)
 - Be recommended by their Sectional Commissioner
 - Be approved by the Contingent Leader
 - Hold a current NPC and NT Working with Children Card

- Other Adult**
- Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia NSW (e.g. Office Holders, Fellowship) at the time of application and through till 16 January 2019
 - Be recommended by their line manager/Group President
 - Be approved by the Contingent Leader
 - Holding a current NPC & NT Working With Children Card

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for the Jamboree must be completed and 'submitted' online. When you have 'submitted' your application, you then need to print it and:

- Under 18 years old (Scouts and Venturers): ensure that both parents and/or guardians (where applicable) sign the Agreement, Activities and Authority form and tick the appropriate 4 boxes for Activities, Authority and Court Order.
- Leaders, Rovers and Other Adult Members: ensure that the Agreement, Activities and Authority form is signed by yourself.

Then all applicants need to obtain the required signatures as follows:

Scouts	Your Scout Leader and Group Leader are required to sign your application form
Venturer Scouts	Your Venturer Leader and Group Leader are required to sign your application form
Leaders / Rovers / Other Adults	Crew / Group Leader or next appropriate level of Commissioner to sign your form

After ensuring you have the required signatures, you will be required to login to the Jamboree Application System and upload the agreement page.

Late applications received by NT Contingent:

- May be accepted if there is room in the planned Jamboree Troop and/or arranged Contingent travel plans.
- Applicants may not be with their home Troop if Jamboree Troops have already been formed and no space is available.
- Applicants cannot be guaranteed any or all of the standard Contingent supplied merchandise, nor will there be a reduction in the amount payable if some items are not available.
- Late applications received by the Contingent after **1 June 2018** will attract a \$250 'Late Fee' payable with the initial payment.
- All applications will close on 31 August 2018.

WITHDRAWALS

If after making application, you are unable to attend the Jamboree, you must advise the Contingent in writing as soon as possible. A withdrawal form will then be made available to you. Please complete this form, Scouts ensure your Scout Leader signs the form and for all others, your Group Leader or next level of Commissioner is required to sign the form. Then forward it to the NT Contingent as soon as possible.

Withdrawals Fees will apply as follows:

The Contingent reserves the right to refuse any application, in which case a full refund will be made.

MEDICAL OBLIGATIONS

Should your medical conditions change from the information provided on your initial application, prior to departure for the Jamboree, it is your obligation to advise the Contingent immediately of such change by updating the online system and by written confirmation directly to the Contingent Office.

TRANSPORT

- Travel arrangements will be co-ordinated by the Contingent and advised closer to the event.
- The above Total Fee includes the cost of travel of participants, to and from the Jamboree.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL FEE

- 11 days to make Friends for Life with activities, on-site and off-site: Arrival date: 4 January 2019, Departure date: 14 January 2019
- Travel to and from the Jamboree.
- All meals for the duration of the Jamboree.
- The costs of contingent merchandise, equipment, transport and contingent administrative / operational costs.

INDEPENDENT TRAVEL

It is expected that Contingent members will travel to and from the Jamboree together. We understand that some families will be on holidays Down South and wish to drop off their Scout themselves. That should be OK but specific times and arrangements need to be made well in advance of required arrival. Remember there will be TEN THOUSAND people arriving to the Jamboree in a 24-hour period. Anyone intending to travel independently needs to advise us in writing as soon as possible by sending an email to aj2019nt@nthq.scouts.com.au. The permission for independent travel will be at the discretion of Contingent Leader and Organising Committee.

There is a need for sufficient adults / Line Leaders to travel with their troop and this will need to be taken into account when deciding on independent travel.
